The School of Social Work invites applications for **three** faculty positions, open rank, each with a starting date of August 16, 2012. We are seeking faculty whose research focuses on health/behavioral health disparities, interventions with school-age children/school social work, and social work with military/veterans and their families. We have a strong focus in the School on intervention research with vulnerable populations. These positions are aligned with the Strategic Excellence Hiring Program at Illinois, focusing on Human Health and Wellness, and three other areas.

The successful candidates will have general expertise in the field of social work, the ability to maintain an active funded research agenda, and a commitment to excellence in teaching. At the Associate Professor or Full Professor rank, candidates must have an established record of funded research, scholarship and teaching, and must meet the University's requirements for that rank. Candidates for Assistant Professor must have clear potential for obtaining external funds for research. A Ph.D. in social work or related field is required; preference will be given to those who also have an MSW.

The University of Illinois at Urbana-Champaign School of Social Work is a freestanding unit renowned for its achievements in research and teaching. The faculty were ranked #1 among social work programs in scholarly productivity in select social work journals. The School is the home of the Children and Family Research Center, which operates in collaboration with the Illinois Department of Children and Family Services.
