Goshen College invites applications for a full-time, tenure track open rank Professor of Social Work beginning August 2012. Teaching responsibilities include Social Welfare Policy and Program I & II, Field Instruction, Introduction to Social Work, and Human Behavior. The mission of Goshen College's accredited Social Work Education Program is to prepare baccalaureate students for beginning level generalist practice with emphasis on social and economic justice, anti-oppressive practice, and engaging effectively across differences. The program is part of the Department of Sociology, Social Work & Anthropology which offers bachelor of arts degrees in sociology and social work. Qualifications

We are seeking candidates committed to excellence in teaching at a liberal arts college. An MSW degree from an accredited program plus two years post-MSW practice experience is required by Fall 2012; in addition, a PhD in social work or a related field is preferred.

Candidates must demonstrate familiarity with the Council on Social Work Education's accreditation standards. Supervisory experience, successful collegiate teaching experience, and knowledge of and facility with appropriate instructional technologies are strongly preferred. The successful candidate will be expected to work collaboratively with students and faculty.
