Candidates who expect to teach practice courses should also have at least two years post-MSW practice experience. Preference given to candidates with teaching experience on the BSW level, MSW leadership experience and with a commitment to teaching excellence and scholarship. Successful candidates should address their abilities to work within a culturally diverse environment and to prepare students to work effectively in a world of increasing diversity in the application.
