- Job Title:** Case Manager for Children and Pregnant Women

- Job Description:** Identify and screen individuals whom have been referred for case management. Provide case management to children and pregnant women with special needs. Must be able to travel between locations as needed. Assess each client's medical and psychosocial history and current service needs. Develop and regularly update a service plan based upon the client's needs and choices. Implement the plan in a timely manner. Provide information, referrals and assistance with linkage to medical and psychosocial services as needed. Monitor the efficacy and quality of services through periodic re-evaluation. Advocate on behalf of clients to decrease service gaps and remove barriers to services. Document service provided in client record within 24 hours. Attend required training and ongoing education offered by the agency. Participate in the Performance Improvement Program. Perform all other duties and tasks as assigned.
- Qualifications:** Bilingual (English/Spanish) is preferred. If the employee is bilingual then they must have written and verbal fluency in English and Spanish. A master's degree from an accredited college or university with a major in social or behavioral sciences. Must be currently licensed by their respective Texas licensure board and whose license is not temporary or provisional in nature. All case managers must maintain their professional licenses as defined by the respective Texas licensing/examining boards. Case managers must comply with all applicable recognitions/designations, such as the Independent Practice Recognition as defined by Texas licensing/examining board. Have two years of cumulative experience in the past ten years working with children, up to age 21, and/or pregnant women and assessing the psychosocial and health needs of clients and their families and making community referrals for these populations. This experience must include the following: paid work experience; or supervised educational social work or registered nurse internship/practicum experience.
