Job Title: Multiple Positions

Job Description: The School of Social Work (SSW) at the University of North Carolina Wilmington invites applications for three open-rank, nine-month academic positions for appointment beginning fall 2013. Appointment at the Assistant, Associate, or Professor rank is dependent on qualifications.

The School of Social Work is one of three professional schools within the College of Health and Human Services, which is committed to interdisciplinary approaches to teaching, research, and community engagement. SSW offers both BSW and MSW programs from the strengths perspective and a foundation in solution-focused practice, with emphasis on practice labs, small classes, and specially reinforced field instruction. The BSW program is offered on the main campus in Wilmington and on the UNCW Onslow Extension campus in Jacksonville, NC, whereas the MSW is currently available only on the main campus. The MSW program has a clinical concentration, with the foundation practice courses based on a Solution-Focused foundation and specialized courses in both cognitive-behavioral and motivational theories. Faculty members teach across programs and on both campuses.

Qualifications: Qualifications include an accredited Master's Degree in Social Work and a PhD in Social Work or a related field. Persons who are ABD will be considered for Assistant Professor rank only; the doctorate is required at the beginning of the year or it must be obtained within first academic year of employment. Candidates for Associate or Full Professor will need to demonstrate a strong publication record and potential for funded scholarship. Persons interested in teaching practice must have at least two years of direct practice experience, with those who can qualify for clinical licensure preferred.

Qualified candidates will demonstrate potential for excellent teaching and scholarly productivity. Faculty conducting community-based or applied research are especially encouraged to apply. We would like candidates to be able to teach in at least two areas of the BSW and MSW Foundation curriculum. Candidates who have research, teaching, and/or practice experience with diverse populations are preferred.
