Job Title: Tenure-Track Faculty Position (Open Rank)

Job Description: The School of Social Work at the University of North Carolina at Chapel Hill invites nominations and applications for one tenure-track position at the rank of Assistant, Associate, or Full Professor. Candidates will join a community of active scholars and are expected to have the ability to obtain external funding to support their research; publish their research findings; infuse their classroom teaching with knowledge based on the latest and strongest evidence; and provide service to the State of North Carolina, the nation, as well as in international settings. We seek applicants with a demonstrated capacity to conduct rigorous research focused on informing, designing, developing, and evaluating social interventions and social policies that strengthen individuals, families and communities in the areas of direct practice, community practice, management, and policy. We hope to hear from applicants with expertise related to social or health problems in a broad array of diverse populations.

Qualifications: Applicants must possess a doctoral degree in social work or a related field or be at an advanced stage of completing a doctoral dissertation. Further, the successful applicant is expected to have demonstrated strong commitments to social work education, research and teaching. Preference will be given to applicants with a master's degree from a CSWE accredited social work program and a minimum of two years of post-masters social work practice experience and also to applicants who have demonstrated the capacity to secure extramural funding for research or who have worked in research groups with substantial extramural funding. Salary is competitive and will be commensurate with experience.
