Job Description: California State University, Long Beach is a large, comprehensive Hispanic-serving university, with a student body of more than 34,000 and 1,900 full and part-time faculty, offering 83 Baccalaureate and 66 Masters degrees in the Liberal Arts, applied and professional fields including two doctoral programs in Education and Engineering.. The College of Health and Human Services in which this position resides has 11 departments, 5,000 majors, 6 centers for research/service and graduates approximately 1,500 students per year.

The School of Social Work employs 29 full-time faculty and enrolls 681 BSW/MSW students. Over the past 15 years, our Social Work faculty and its Child Welfare Training Center has assumed leadership in attracting over \$94 million dollars in extramural funds and secured almost \$21 million on behalf of local Long Beach human services and education agencies. Over 70% of our students are of color, predominantly Latino. We have a diverse faculty and are committed to integrating multicultural content into all of our courses and activities.

Qualifications: A Master's Degree in Social Work and a Ph.D. or D.S.W. in Social Work or closely related field, or have ABD status with doctorate completed at the time of appointment; two years' experience in Social Work; evidence of ability to publish scholarly work, conduct research, and secure external funding. Commitment to and/or expertise in educating a diverse student population.

DESIRED/PREFERRED QUALIFICATIONS: Demonstrated teaching/training experience at the university level; two or more years of post-master's employment experience as a social worker; evidence of a record of scholarly and/or applied human services activities; evidence of one or more specialty areas in macro practice such as social policy, community practice or administration. Research and/or practice with communities of color.
