Job Description	Elizabethtown College invites applications for a full-time tenure track position in Social Work starting August 2014. Course load will include social policy, as well as other courses across the curriculum. It is planned that this person will begin teaching in the First-Year seminar program after acclimation. Additional responsibilities include academic advising of students, sharing in committee work, and professional development. A background that suggests the ability to mentor and challenge students in a way that inspires is desired. The department seeks candidates with dynamic teaching skills who are able to excite students about the profession as well as contribute to the knowledge base of the profession. Also desired are candidates who can contribute in meaningful ways to the diversity and intercultural goals of the College. The college follows the Teacher- Scholar model and course workload is three 4-credit courses per semester. Internal funds and grants are available for scholarship and professional development.
Qualifications	Ph.D. in Social Work is preferred; however, advanced ABDs or those with a PhD in a closely affiliated field will be considered. An MSW from a CSWE-accredited institution is required, with at least 2 years of post-MSW practice experience required, preferably in policy work. Candidates must have teaching experience in higher education and show evidence of a research agenda. Finalists will be required to submit original transcripts and copies of recent course evaluations.
