Assistant Professor, Macro:

Minimum Qualifications: MSW; completed Doctorate in Social Work preferred, ABD accepted. Eligible for New Jersey licensure. Extensive BSW and/or MSW practice, leadership and/or teaching experience; at least 3-4 years of MSW practice experience; excellent communicator; collegial work style and a commitment to advocate for the interests of the School and the profession. Demonstrated record of scholarship, teaching and service sufficient to warrant a tenure track appointment as an Assistant Professor. Competence and interest in any area of social work, especially policy and/or community practice. The successful candidate must have a demonstrated commitment to social justice and human rights.

Assistant Professor, Clinical:

Minimum Qualifications: MSW; completed Doctorate in Social Work preferred, ABD accepted. Eligible for New Jersey licensure. Extensive BSW and/or MSW practice, leadership and/or teaching experience; at least 3-4 years of MSW practice experience; excellent communicator; collegial work style and a commitment to advocate for the interests of the School and the profession. Demonstrated record of scholarship, teaching and service sufficient to warrant a tenure track appointment as an Assistant Professor. Competence and interest in any area of clinical social work; work with children especially helpful. The successful candidate must have a demonstrated commitment to social justice and human rights.

Lecturer:

Minimum Qualifications: MSW required; completed Doctorate in Social Work preferred; eligible for New Jersey licensure. Extensive BSW and/or MSW practice and/or teaching experience; at least four years Social Work practice experience preferred; excellent communicator; collegial work style and a commitment to advocate for the interests of the School and the profession. Competence and interest in teaching HBSE, Practice, Field and Research. The successful candidate must have a demonstrated commitment to social justice and human rights.

Specialist Professor:

Minimum Qualifications: Completed MSW; eligible for New Jersey licensure. Full time BSW and/or MSW teaching experience preferred. At least four years Social Work practice experience preferred with an expertise in micro and/or macro social work. Demonstrated evidence of maintaining professional currency and ability to develop new curriculum; excellent communicator; collegial work style and a commitment to advocate for the interests of the School and the profession. The successful candidate will have a demonstrated commitment to social justice and human rights.
