The selected candidate will teach a variety of courses in the School to support both undergraduate and graduate programs. Candidates with a history or strong potential of effective university teaching, a history or strong potential for research resulting in external funding and peer-reviewed publication, and a commitment to service at the department, college, and university levels will be considered. Applicants for Associate Professor will have a record of service, teaching and research that is commiserate with that rank.

**Minimum qualifications include:**

- An earned doctorate in Social Work, Social Welfare, or another closely-related degree
- An MSW from a CSWE accredited program
- Minimum of 2 years fulltime post-MSW practice experience
- Consideration will be given to doctoral candidates who are ABD and whose graduation date is spring or summer 2015
- A strong commitment to working with students and fostering their professional development

**The preferred candidate will have:**

- Experience or strong potential for research as evidenced by a record of peer-reviewed publication and/or external funding
- Experience or strong potential for teaching at both the undergraduate and graduate levels in micro and/or macro practice social science research, and/or HBSE
- Willingness to engage in, or experience in on-line education
- Eligible for licensure in the State of Idaho
