The Graduate College of Social Work (GCSW) at the University of Houston, one of only three Carnegie-Designated Tier One Public Research Universities in Texas, is accepting applications for a full-time, senior-level faculty member commencing AY 2016-2017. The successful candidate will have an extensive federally-funded research record and expertise in Behavioral Health (mental health or substance abuse), Public Health, or Intervention Research.

QUALIFICATIONS: Ph.D. in Social Work or related field. Preference will be given to applicants who are full professors or associate professors with tenure, and have a strong research record with demonstrated success in securing extramural research funding. **Persons from underrepresented groups are especially encouraged to apply.**

RANK: Associate or Full Professor

The University of Houston's GCSW is the only graduate social work program located in the fourth largest city in the U.S. Houston is an international and multicultural city, and the University and College reflect this diversity. The University of Houston has been designated as a Hispanic Serving Institution, and is recognized as the second most racially and ethnically diverse research institution in the nation, with students coming from more than 137 nations. The fall 2015 incoming GCSW MSW class speaks 19 different languages. The GCSW is located on the University of Houston main campus, in close proximity to the Texas Medical Center, which is home to The MD Anderson Cancer Center, the Menninger Clinic, UT Medical School, Michael E. DeBakey Veteran's Administration Medical Center, and Baylor College of Medicine, among many other institutions. This environment is rich in potential for numerous collaborative opportunities in health and behavioral health research. Over the last 5 years, the GCSW faculty have secured over 20 million dollars in external grant funding. Research is primarily under the auspices of the College's Center for Drug and Social Policy Research and The Child and Family Center for Innovative Research. As a graduate-only College, the GCSW serves approximately 400 MSW and 30 Ph.D. students each year. Our MSW program is ranked in the top 20% of all social work programs, and offers traditional, hybrid and online curriculum options. Our established doctoral program focuses on developing scholars that contribute to evidence-based social work.
