

Requirements to meet the FLO

Global Leaders of Behavioral Health Education (GLOBE)

Requirements and Description – Students must meet the following eligibility requirements to apply to and be considered for the GLOBE FLO. The student must:

- Be entering Practicum 3
- Declare a clinical concentration and have strong interest in delivering clinical services in mental health and/or substance use disorder treatment
- Complete Practicum 3 and Practicum 4 by August
- Have a 3.0 undergraduate GPA and maintain a 3.5 graduate GPA
- Commit to work with culturally and linguistically diverse populations in a mental or behavioral health capacity in Harris County for two years post-graduation from the MSW program
- Be a U.S. permanent resident or citizen

It is preferred that students be bilingual (English/Spanish), but this is not a requirement.

Students must complete all four of the following components for the FLO.

Practicum Education – Those who are selected as GLOBE participants will be required to do Practicums 3 and 4 at placements that deliver behavioral health services in an integrated setting.

Course Requirements – GLOBE participants are required to complete the following course offered in the spring for those in the face to face program and the summer for those in the online and hybrid programs.

- SOCW 7378-Behavioral Health for Social Work Practice in Integrated Healthcare

Training – GLOBE participants are required to attend four GLOBE workshops per year.

Other – GLOBE participants are asked to commit to working with culturally and linguistically diverse populations in a mental or behavioral health capacity in Harris County for two years post-graduation from the MSW program.
