THE SOCIAL WORK POST GRADUATE PROGRAM PROVIDES A 1 - 2-YEAR, IN PERSON, POST-MASTERS GRADUATE TRAINING WITH EXTENSIVE CLINICAL EXPERIENCE, SUPERVISION, EDUCATIONAL OPPORTUNITIES. SOCIAL WORKERS RECEIVE FULL UNIVERSITY EMPLOYEE BENEFITS AND A STIPEND WHILE THEY WORK TOWARDS INDEPENDENT LICENSURE.

Job Description	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Full time, salaried positions (these aren't private practice positions where you're needing to recruit cash-pay clients) - Full Texas A&M employee benefits, including fantastic health benefits and TRS pension retirement - Included clinical supervision - Ample clinical hours. Outside of time each week specifically devoted to training/supervision, most of a fellow's work hours are direct clinical practice in individual, group, and family therapy. These are NOT primarily case management/skills training positions with window dressing to qualify for clinical hours under a supervision plan. - Working in an integrated, interdisciplinary care setting, co-located with primary care, psychiatry, nursing, psychology, and researchers. - Weekly didactic training in new research, different treatment modalities, and other applicable practice topics alongside medical students, psychiatry and family practice residents, and PhD psychology students. - Training in both best practices for telehealth and in-person service delivery <p>The positions are:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - In person. While we will continue to deliver a substantial portion of our services via telehealth going forward (something we were leaders in doing even before COVID!), we do require these positions to work out of our physical clinic in Bryan/College Station to allow for more thorough training and supervision. - 1-2 years. We intend for these positions to be a launchpad to independent clinical licensure and practice, either with us in a more senior position or out in the greater local, state, or national community. - Require your LMSW (or the ability to get one very soon), as well as the ability to be employed in the U.S. - Require some clinical experience during their MSW field placements (or as LMSWs)
