You will also complete accurate client records for monthly reports.</li><li>• You will communicate with on-call staff including Supervisors, Crisis Hotline/Chat Counselors, SANE nurses, law enforcement, and community partners.</li><li>• You will communicate with Coordinator Supervisor and other hotline staff regarding case management and other issues.</li><li>• You will attend mandatory monthly meetings and trainings with Hospital Accompaniment Crisis Counselors &amp; Supervisor, all department Staff meetings, and/or meet as assigned.</li><li>• You always maintain sufficient inventory while on-call of information packets and clothing for clients. Supplies provided by agency.</li><li>• Other duties as assigned. Should such duties become routine, the job description will be reviewed and revised.</li></ul> |
