	 Answer helpline calls, complete intakes, provide crisis intervention and counseling, and assess needs for appropriate intervention and referrals. Use specialized clinical knowledge and advanced clinical skills to assess, diagnose, and treat mental, emotional, and behavioral disorders, conditions, and emotional disturbances in adult survivors of domestic violence and sexual assault. Through a culturally competent lens, apply theory, knowledge, methods, ethics, and the professional use of self to restore and enhance social and psychosocial functioning of clients through regular therapy sessions.
	 Assess lethality and provide crisis management counseling both on the helpline and in ongoing therapy sessions. Integrate various therapeutic interventions such as Cognitive Behavioral Therapy (CBT), Eye Movement Desensitization and Reprocessing
	 (EMDR), Solution-Focused Brief Therapy (SFBT), and Motivational Interviewing (MI) into counseling sessions with clients. Provide supportive legal, criminal justice, and housing advocacy as needed. Examples include assisting with obtaining protective orders, law enforcement accompaniment, and assisting in locating safe housing. Assist in organizing and conducting therapeutic support groups and
	 workshops. Track client communication and maintain accurate client records within the client database.
