The program provides comprehensive support for participants through programming that develops social-emotional and academic skills. The program seeks to ensure students graduate high school and access post-secondary education.</p> <p>The TFI Program Coach will assist the TFI Program Manager in the facilitation of TFI programming. TFI Program Coach will provide mentorship services to TFI fellows. DiscoverU is seeking an individual who has experience working with young men of color. The Program Coach must be engaging in a classroom setting and have the ability to build positive relationships.</p> <p>The TFI Program Coach position is a Houston-based position. The TFI Program Coach position is a part-time position beginning in April 2021. The position will require weekend hours. The TFI Program Coach reports directly to DiscoverU’s TFI Program Manager.</p> <p>The Program Coach will be responsible for critical activities including, but not limited to the following:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Program Support: Assist the TFI Program Manager in facilitating the TFI Program.</li> <li>• Program Coordination: Assist in case-management and program retention efforts.</li> <li>• Communications: Help build and maintain communication with TFI stakeholders</li> <li>• Performance Management: assists in collecting data points that help benchmark Fellows’ academic, social, and emotional development.</li> <li>• External Representation: Represent the program in meetings with program partners, Fellows’ parents, school leaders, interested community members, and other constituencies.</li> </ul>
