<b>Job Description</b>	<p>In this position, you will be a trainee of the Texas Children's comprehensive palliative care clinical services and interdisciplinary professional training services. This educational opportunity will prepare the fellow to provide specialized palliative care to seriously ill children and their caregivers, with an emphasis on advocacy. At the end of this fellowship, the social worker will be prepared to offer highly specialized, empathic care in palliative care and hospice settings, quality improvement, and education. Additional learning opportunities are available based on the fellow's experience and areas of professional interest</li> <li>• Attend regularly scheduled and required meetings and appointments as appropriate and participate in development workshops</li> </ul>
