Develops a treatment plan that will support the patient's ongoing recovery and development with supervisors. Assesses the psychosocial functioning of youth and parents throughout the treatment program; conducts interviews with patients and significant others to determine assets as well as challenges to optimal patient functioning both while in the program. Establishes and maintains relationships with community resources to assist with patients' medical participant's needs for ongoing support. Refers patients and families to community resources.
