Job Description	<p>Reports to: Chief of Programs</p> <p>Position Summary: This position is responsible for providing direct services to clients who have a substance use disorder diagnosis, a co-occurring disorder, or other mental health diagnosis. Services include individual and group counseling, family counseling, couple counseling and psychoeducational groups to youth and adults.</p> <p>I. Essential Duties and Responsibilities</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Provide one - two hours weekly of individual therapy to assigned clients • Facilitate or co-facilitate various group types that may include children, teens and adults • Facilitate/supervise client study of recovery-oriented materials and offer support/guidance • Conduct full clinical assessments on each client • Develop treatment and discharge plans with new clients and the full treatment team • Provide crisis counseling, suicide assessments and support as needed to clients • Act as advocate and liaison with other service providers and staff members when appropriate • Provide services aimed at relapse prevention • Provide psycho-educational groups/ programs • Participate in treatment and discharge planning for clients • Maintain documentation in client's charts daily <p>II.
