Berenice Pérez Ramírez, PhD is currently a Full-time Professor-Researcher at the National School of Social Work of the National Autonomous University of Mexico (SNI Level 1). She is co-coordinator of the WG "Critical Studies in Disability", which brings together researchers from 9 countries in Latin America, sponsored by CLACSO. Her main lines of research are: gender studies, body studies, trans issues, disability and prison. Since 2015, she has been carrying out projects with students for different prisons in Mexico City in the implementation of qualitative methodologies. As of 2018, she works with people who have been diagnosed with psychosocial disability in prison and with the staff of these centers. The objective is to refute the stigmata about people, perform a diagnostic investigation to generate proposals that reduce symptoms and promote their recovery through a support system.
