## STEM ZONE SATURDAY BUILDS

### RELATIONSHIPS

Students develop peer relationships that nurture confidence and a sense of belonging

### RIGOR

Students engage in authentic, hands-on inquiry based STEM activities

### RELEVANCE

Students identify real world problems and explore innovative solutions

*In the U.S., female, minority, and economically disadvantaged students are underrepresented in STEM majors and careers.*

Factors that influence reduced engagement in STEM:

1. Few female and minority role models
2. Little real world application found in math and science courses
3. Low student research population
