The firm presented their findings but there were concerns regarding the pricing structure of the meal plans, swipe usage rates, longer hours, and higher quality foods. The food court lines at the Student Centers were the 3rd worst of the survey results.
 - Fact finding mission Eve Esch went to George Mason & Liberty University with individuals from Auxiliary Services to inspect their dining operation. George Mason: close to a large city, commuter type school, and recently has seen an increase in the number of students living on campus. Both schools are operated by Sodexo.
