


## Provide - Affordable Housing

Nearly 1 in 2 Houston renters spends more than 30% of their income on rent or mortgage.



## Establishment

The Houston City Council created the Houston Housing Authority in response to federal legislation (U.S. Housing Act of 1937).

# Recruitment Process..

## After You Apply..



### Step 1

#### Initial call

If you meet the minimum qualifications for the position you applied for, one of our recruiters will reach out to you to schedule a short, informal call to get to know you and your work experience.



### Step 2

#### Assessment

Based on your experience and how our informal call goes, we will schedule you for a pre-assessment to assess your skills.



### Step 3

#### In-person interview

If you receive a passing score on your pre-assessment for the position you applied for, we will reach out to you to schedule a formal interview.



### Step 4

#### Final decision

After the final interview concludes, you will be informed of the outcome of your potential employment within a few days.

#### Onboarding
