


The Future of Fossil Fuels

In simple terms, for an equal amount of electricity produced, a wind generating facility requires 250 times to 10,000 times the amount of land a fossil fuels generating facility requires.


IN CLEAN ENERGY METALS


Renewable sources of energy are expected to replace fossil fuels in the next decades, as the world's economies try to reduce carbon emissions and mitigate climate change.


Injected underground to enhance recovery of oil in a depleted reservoir.




