Students are admitted to the Undergraduate Business Program as Pre-Business. Upon completion of requirements to file a degree plan, students declare a specific major in Business. The Bauer College of Business offers the following majors, with special tracks in some majors:

- Accounting
- Entrepreneurship (special admission requirements)
- Finance
- Management
- Management Information Systems (MIS)
- Marketing
- Supply Chain Management (SCM)

*All majors for the B.B.A. allow for 9 hours of General Elective credit. Students with transfer credit of 6 hours for Institutionally Designated Component Area Options and/or 3 hours of Social and Behavioral Science in addition to ECON 2301 or ECON 2302 may transfer those credits as General Electives toward the B.B.A., or utilize the 9 hours of General Electives for any unused transferable courses.

- Effective fall 2019 BCIS 1305 includes additional Excel programming. Students with transfer credit for BCIS 1305 waive with substitution the MIS 3300 requirement for the B.B.A. However, a passing score on a UH Bauer College Excel Competency Exam is required of all Pre-business majors in order to file a degree plan to declare a specific major in business (for further information and online preparation materials, see “Excel Competency Exam” at: www.bauer.uh.edu/undergraduate/advising).
