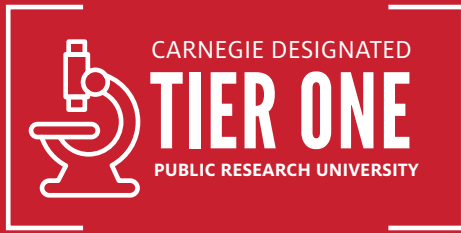

Pay the \$75 application fee, \$90 for international.
- 3 SELF-REPORT TRANSCRIPT**
Self-report your grades and class rank in your MyUH portal.
- 4 SEND TEST SCORES**
Send ACT or SAT score(s) directly from the testing agency if you want us to consider a test score.
- 5 ATTEND ORIENTATION**
If admitted, commit to UH by registering for orientation.

ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS

Choose to submit your application with a test score or without. If you apply with test scores, we will only use the highest total or composite score from one sitting. UH does not super score.

ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS

FRESHMAN

MINIMUM GRADES/MARKS

Minimum 3.0 equivalent GPA (4.0 scale).

Graduates from an accredited U.S. high school: meet U.S. freshman admission requirements. (See page 4.)

ENGLISH LANGUAGE REQUIREMENTS (ELR)

Completed high school in a non-English speaking country: meet ELR minimum scores below.

Completed high school in a country where English is the native language: take the SAT or ACT.

TRANSFER

MINIMUM GRADES/MARKS

Minimum 3.0 equivalent GPA (4.0 scale) in at least 15 transferable credits. If you've earned less than 15 hours of college-level credit, freshman admission criteria will need to be met.

Transfers from a U.S. college/university: meet U.S. transfer admission requirements. (See page 5.)

ENGLISH LANGUAGE REQUIREMENTS (ELR)

Transfers from a college/university in a non-English speaking country: meet ELR minimum score.

Transfers from an accredited U.S. college: exempt from ELR with an AA or AS degree or a B or better in English 1301 or equivalent.

- 2 APPLICATION FEE**
Pay the \$90 application fee.
- 3 SUBMIT TEST SCORES**
Send official test scores directly from the testing agency.
- 4 SEND ACADEMIC RECORDS**
Send all official academic records and/or transcripts from secondary, high school and/or colleges and university entrance examinations when appropriate.
- 5 ATTEND ORIENTATION**
Admitted students are provided instructions to receive an I-20 and can then register for orientation and enroll in classes.
