FRESHMAN STUDENTS

In addition to meeting all general freshman admission requirements listed below — all Music, Theatre and Dance applicants must submit a College of the Arts application and participate in an audition.

Art, Graphic Design, Painting, Photography/Digital Media and Sculpture applicants must submit a College of the Arts application and portfolio.

Art History applicants must submit a College of the Arts application and essay.

TRANSFER STUDENTS

In addition to meeting all general transfer admission requirements listed below — all Dance, Music and Theatre applicants must submit a College of the Arts application and participate in an audition.

Art, Graphic Design, Painting, Photography/Digital Media and Sculpture applicants must successfully complete six hours of Art or Art History coursework, and submit a College of the Arts application and portfolio.

Art History applicants must successfully complete six hours of Art or Art History coursework, and submit a College of the Arts application and essay.

General Transfer Admission Requirements

**If you've earned less than 15 hours of college-level credit, you'll have to meet freshman admission criteria to be admitted. Only credits obtained after earning a high school credential will be counted toward the 15 hours.
