

### COUGAR PROMISE

We'll cover tuition and fees for those with an adjusted gross family income at or below \$65,000. Tuition support is provided for those with an adjusted gross family income between \$65,001 and \$125,000. ### OUT-OF-STATE TUITION WAIVER

Out-of-state and international students who receive \$1,000 or more from various competitive University scholarships may qualify for an out-of-state tuition waiver. This means waiver recipients will pay in-state tuition rates.


