Subject: Changes in requirements for Computer Science majors

Date: 6 March 2004

The Curriculum Committee of the College of Natural Sciences and Mathematics has voted to support the request of the Department of Computer Science to change the FTIC entry requirements for potential Computer Science majors. The current requirements (listed on p. 275 of the 2005 – 2007 Undergraduate Catalog) are as follows:

Freshman Admission to Computer Science

Applicants will be admitted as computer science majors if they meet the following minimum standards:

Rank in Class	Minimum Score for Admission to Department		
	SAT (after 3/95)	Verbal	ACT
Top 10%	1100	550	24
1 st quarter	1100	550	24
2 nd quarter	1150	550	25
3 rd quarter	1200	550	26
4 th quarter			Not admissible

The Department of Computer Science wishes to eliminate these requirements for incoming freshmen and use the same standards as the rest of the College – which are the basic entry requirements of the University (page 16 of the 2005 – 2007 Undergraduate Catalog). The current requirements, as listed above, should be removed from the Undergraduate Catalog upon approval by the Undergraduate Council.
