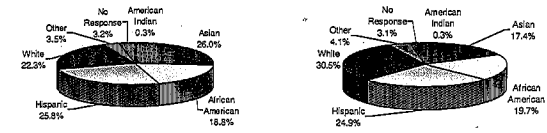

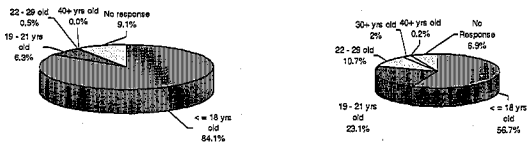
Demographic: Ethnicity

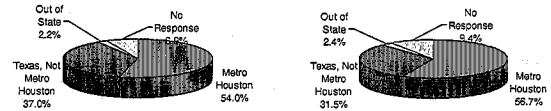
Demographic: Age

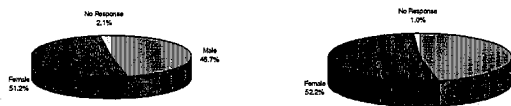
Demographic: Current Residence

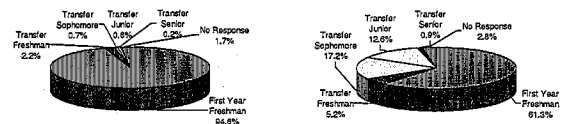
Demographic: Gender

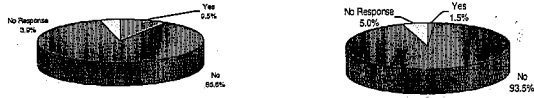
Demographic: Classification

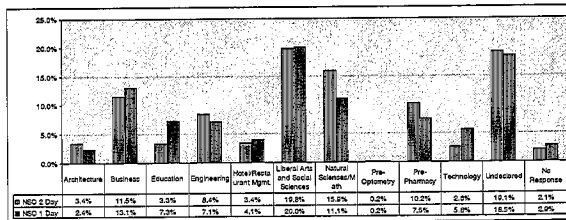

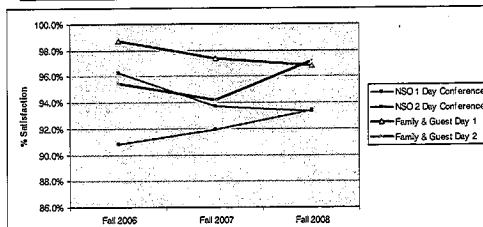
