The College of Architecture has 3 undergraduate degree programs that require more than 120 credit hours. I have been asked to provide the Undergraduate Council a rationale for the number of credits in these programs.

Bachelor of Architecture

160 hours

The Bachelor of Architecture is an accredited program by the National Architectural Accrediting Board (NAAB). NAAB does not accredit 4-year programs. Our program of 160 credits is well within the national range for 5-year accredited programs.

Bachelor of Science in Environmental Design

128 hours

The Bachelor of Science in Environmental Design is a pre-professional degree program. It needs to meet the normal requirements for those students who continue at the graduate level to pursue the First Professional Degree in architecture. 128 hours is well within the range of such programs nationally.

Bachelor of Science in Industrial Design

132 hours

The Bachelor of Science in Industrial Design is a professional degree program. We are in the process of pursuing accreditation from National Association of Schools of Art and Design. 132 hours is within the range of industrial design programs nationally.
