University Honors and Honors in Major

To graduate with *University Honors and Honors in Major* students must write a senior honors thesis or complete an equivalent project, in addition to completing The Honors College curriculum (36 hours).

Membership in The Honors College

Students who complete The Honors College curriculum (36 hours) and elect not to complete a senior honors thesis graduate with *Membership in The Honors College*.

University Honors

1. Students who fulfill the requirements of their major field of study with distinction and write a senior honors thesis outside of their major graduate with *University Honors*.
2. Students who fulfill the requirements of The Honors College and write a senior honors thesis outside of their major field of study graduate with *University Honors*.

Honors in Major

Students who fulfill the requirements of their major with distinction and write a senior honors thesis graduate with *Honors in Major*.

Participation in The Honors College

Students who affiliate with The Honors College throughout their undergraduate career but who do not complete The Honors College curriculum (36 hours) graduate with *Participation in The Honors College*. (**Not currently noted on transcript.**)

Honors College Graduation Designations

Students who affiliate with The Honors College are eligible for the following graduation distinctions:

University Honors with Honors in Major

Students who complete The Honors College curriculum (36 hours) and complete a senior honors thesis graduate with *University Honors with Honors in Major*.

University Honors

Students who complete The Honors College curriculum (36 hours) and elect not to complete a senior honors thesis graduate with *University Honors*.

Collegiate Honors with Honors in Major

1. Students who fulfill the requirements of the honors program in the college of their major, including 21 hours of honors courses, and complete a senior honors thesis, graduate with *Collegiate Honors with Honors in Major*.
2. Students who complete an Honors College minor, or 21 hours of approved honors courses, and complete a senior honors thesis, graduate with *Collegiate Honors with Honors in Major*.

Collegiate Honors

1. Students who fulfill the requirements of the honors program in the college of their major, including 21 hours of honors courses, and elect not to complete a senior honors thesis, graduate with *Collegiate Honors*.
2. Students who complete an Honors College minor, or 21 hours of approved honors courses, and elect not to complete a senior honors thesis, graduate with *Collegiate Honors*.

Membership in The Honors College with Honors in Major

Students who fulfill the requirements of their major with distinction and write a Senior Honors Thesis graduate with *Honors in Major with Membership in The Honors College*.

Membership in The Honors College

Students who affiliate with The Honors College during their undergraduate years but complete fewer than 21 hours of honors courses and elect not to complete a senior honors thesis graduate with *Membership in The Honors College*.
