Petroleum Engineering Minor

Engineering students who choose to minor in Petroleum Engineering must complete the general requirements for a minor with at least 15 hours in Petroleum Engineering including PETR 5364, PETR 5361, PETR 5328, PETR 5304, and PETR 3362. Pre-requisite and/or co-requisites must be observed and will be enforced.

Students should consult the **Academic Regulations and Degree Requirements** section of this catalog for general information on the requirements for minors, consult the Academic Advisor in their major department, and apply to the Academic Advisor for Petroleum Engineering.

Students must earn a 2.00 minimum cumulative grade point average on all courses attempted in the minor discipline at the University of Houston. No course may count toward the minor in which a grade of less than C- is earned.
