## **Degree Plans**

# UC 11341 11F: French Major Degree Program Changes

The French Program Faculty request the following change to the Catalog language:

## Current paragraph:

In addition to the other requirements for the Bachelor of Arts, students will complete 27 semester hours in French at the advanced level (3000 and 4000) to include the following:

- 1. Twelve semester hours at the advanced level, as follows: FREN 3312, 3313, 3314, and 3320.
- 2. Nine semester hours chosen from FREN 3311, 3316, 3317, 3318, 4313, 4315, 4316, or 4317.
- 3. Six semester hour of a French Literature course at the 4000-level.

### To be replaced with:

In addition to the other requirements for the Bachelor of Arts, students will complete 27 semester hours in French at the advanced level (3000 and 4000) to include the following:

- 1. Six semester hours at the advanced level, as follows: FREN 3313 and FREN 3320.
- 2. Fifteen semester hours chosen from 3000 or 4000 level language and culture courses.
- 3. Six semester hours of French or Francophone literature courses at the 4000 level.

Students starting a major in French should work in close consultation with the departmental undergraduate advisor to ensure that their degree plan is coherent, well-balanced, and appropriate to their long-range goals.

#### Justification:

- 1. Required courses are no longer taught every semester, making it difficult for students to complete their degree in French within a reasonable time. The resulting needed course substitutions resulted in non-ideal course sequencing, unpredictable enrollments in courses, and course cancellations.
- 2. The changes will not affect the number of semester hours for the degree, or the literature requirements. Prerequisite course FREN 3313, Advanced Grammar, will now be taught every semester to accommodate student demand. French minors will not be affected by this change. Course distribution will change, but the content of the curriculum will not.

The new requirements will result in more flexibility in organizing a balanced course rotation which will enhance graduation rates and upper level enrollments without unduly penalizing students. The new requirements will allow language, culture, and literature courses to be more evenly distributed in each semesters offering, with at least one course in each of the three areas being offered each semester.

The Subcommittee recommends approval of the French Major Degree Program Changes.

# UC 11522 11F: Catalog Changes Required if COMM 3373 CBM003 is Approved

The Valenti School of Communication submitted a CBM003 to change COMM 4379, Television and Culture, to COMM 3373, Television: History and Culture. If approved, this will require the following Catalog Changes.

A. Add COMM 3373 to the course list and remove COMM 4379.

Concentration in Media Studies

- 3. In addition to the required courses, students must take 18 advanced hours (six courses) from COMM 3334, 3350, 3360, 3362, 3368, 3370, 3372, <u>3373</u>, 3375, 3376, 4314, 4337, 4338, 4350, 4355, 4364, 4367, 4370, 4372, 4374, 4376, <u>4379</u>, 4392, 4397, 1398.
- B. COM 3373 will be added as an approved elective to the following concentrations: Advertising, Corporate Communications, Integrated Communication, Interpersonal Communication, Media Production, and Public Relations.

The Subcommittee recommends approval of the changes in the Valenti School of Communication catalog listing.

### UC 11523 11F: Catalog Changes Required if COMM 4377 CBM003 is Approved

The Valenti School of Communication has submitted a CBM003 for COMM 4377, Understanding Publics. If approved the COMM 4377 will need to be added to each of the course listings in the Catalog for each of the following concentrations.
