RE: Catalog correction: Amending the Film Studies Minor curriculum to reflect a change in a course offered by the School of Art and approved as an elective for the minor

Background:

The School of Art no longer offers ART 1300 Fundamentals of Visual Perception, a course approved as an elective in the Valenti School of Communication's Film Studies Minor. ARTH 1300 Ways of Seeing: Art and our Visual World, now offered in the School of Arts' Art History program should be substituted in the Film Studies Minor.

If approved, the following changes would need to be made to catalog language:

Minor in Film Studies

Students seeking a minor in film studies must meet the following requirements:

 A minimum of 18 semester hours of which at least 12 are advanced. Included in the requirement is COMM 1301 and a sequence of two courses, COMM 3370 and COMM 4370.

Students also must complete nine semester hours of electives to be selected from the following courses:

ART 1300, ART 1370, ARTH 1300, COMM 2370, 3321, 3379, 4328, 4375, 4376, 4392; ENGL 4373; FREN 3318 or 3319; GERM 3380, 3395; HIST 4314; ITAL 3305 or 3306; MAS 3341; PHIL 3361; THEA 2342; other appropriate selected topics or interdisciplinary courses in the College of Liberal Arts and Social Sciences approved by the School of Communication.

- 2. A minimum of nine semester hours in residence, of which at least six are advanced.
- A minimum 2.00 cumulative grade point average for all courses attempted in the minor at the University of Houston with at least a C in each course.
