Degree Plans

UC 11419 11F: Industrial Engineering Degree Plan Update

The Industrial Engineering Degree Plan in the Undergraduate Catalog should have the following changes.

INDE 4315, Supply Chain Design and Management, should replace ^IINDE 3315, Supply Chain Design and Management, in the spring semester of the fourth year.

INDE 4370, Discrete Event Simulation, should replace INDE 3370, Discrete Event Simulation, in the fall semester of the fourth year.

INDE 4320, Computer Integrated Manufacturing, should replace INDE 3320, Computer-Integrated Manufacturing, in the fall semester of the fourth year.

UC 11661 12S: Addition of Senior Experience Requirement to the English Major Concentration

The English Department faculty wishes to add a Senior Experience to the English major concentrations in Creative Writing and Literature.

Rational: The English Major exposes students to a wide range of subject matter and skill-sets. The Senior Experience will provide an opportunity for the student to reflect on his or her training as an English Major; to build on it through mentored independent research and writing; to use it to reflect on his or her academic experience and to envision how it will carry into a future of life-long learning; and to position their work within a larger community.

Proposal: A three semester hour Senior Experience to be required of all English literature and a final writing project to be required of all creative writing majors will be added to the curriculum. No additional hours are required in the degree plan because the changes will mean a reduction in the elective requirements from 12 semester hours to nine semester hours for the English literature concentration, and a prerequisite of senior forms courses that are already required, fiction forms

or poetry forms, will be added to the creative writing projects course requirements in the creative writing concentration.

The literature option can meet the Senior Experience Requirement with a three semester hour research-intensive seminar; English 4319, English in the secondary schools; ENGL 4390, professional Internship; ENGL 4399, Senior Honors thesis; a three semester hour advanced community engagement or service learning course; or a three semester hour study abroad course.

The creative writing can be met with ENGL 4353, Writing Projects: Fiction, or ENGL 4354, Writing Projects: Poetry.

Detailed catalog language for the Senior Experience requirement was provided by the English Department faculty.
