RE: Catalog correction: Amending the Health Communication minor approved courses

Background:

Further review by the Valenti School Undergraduate Committee, advisors and faculty who teach in the Health Communication concentration has revealed changes that should be made in the approved courses listed in the catalog for the Health Communication minor.

Action:

1. Delete COMM 3305 Communication and Catastrophic Illnesses and COMM 3375 from the Group 3 list of electives approved for the minor. Neither of these courses is regularly taught, and COMM 3375 is actually a course designed for the Journalism concentration.

If approved, catalog language would change as follows:

Minor in Health Communication

Students seeking a minor in health communication must meet the following requirements:

- 1. A minimum of 18 semester hours.
- Required foundation course: COMM 3300 (formerly 4333): Health Communication.
- Select 15 hours from: COMM 3301, 3302, 3303, 3304, 3305-3340, 3375-or 4335.

Note: Previously, changes have been submitted to add COMM 1301 and 1302 to Group 2 and to reduce Group 3 to 9 hours.
