RE: Proposal to discontinue the International Area Studies Minors

The Bauer College of Business proposes to the UH Undergraduate Committee to discontinue the International Area Studies Minors, with regional specializations in Africa, Asia, Europe, Latin America, and the Middle East.

Justification: Due to the proposed discontinuation of INTB 3351, 3352, and 3353, the International Area Studies Minors are no longer functional. Students interested in international business and globalization are encouraged to consider the proposed Business Foundations Minor, which includes an option to take INTB 3354 and 3355, or minors in the College of Liberal Arts and Social Science with an international focus.
