III Introduction of John J. Antel, newly-appointed Senior Vice President for Academic Affairs and Provost

Vice Chair Simon Bott welcomed John Antel to the Undergraduate Council meeting. Dr. Antel expressed his eagerness to work with the Undergraduate Council on new initiatives regarding undergraduate curriculum, student services and new degree programs to enhance and improve the undergraduate experience. He informed the Council that a national search will soon be underway to

hire an assistant vice president for Enrollment Services. Dr. Antel also mentioned that he would like to establish honors programs in the colleges. This new initiative wouldn't replace the Honors College, but may complement it. These honors programs would gear more towards undergraduates in there junior and senior years: providing more challenge during the student's academic career. Lastly, John Antel followed up with a Q and A session with the council members.

Debbie Hermann brought forth the concern regarding the Six W policy and how it affects the business processes in RAR with special emphasis on lecture/lab classes. If a student were to drop a lab section of a lecture/lab class taken in a subsequent semester, it would count as a W (one drop). Currently, the PeopleSoft program doesn't have an automatic mechanism to drop lecture/lab classes simultaneously, unless they're manually associated together. Debbie proposed that a subcommittee be created to discuss this issue. Dr. Simon Bott suggested to Council members that research needs to be done among their respective constituents to find out which classes would be affected by this policy and inform Debbie. It was also suggested that language be amended to add that lecture/lab classes dropped simultaneously "within the semester" would count as one drop. Lastly, any member interested in joining this subcommittee would need to contact Debbie Hermann in Registration and Academic Records.
