VI Achieving the Dream

Libby Barlow gave a brief overview of Achieving the Dream (AtD) project. It is basically a grant that focuses on transfer student success (community college to four-year university transition). AtD identifies three areas for transfer student success: orientation (advising and registration), transcript imaging programs (i.e., USelect), and transfer advising program. A coach and a data coach visit the institutions about three to four times a year and give constructive feedback.

Libby Barlow introduced the Achieving the Dream coaches Drs. Vasti Torres and George Kuh to the Undergraduate Council. Dr. George Kuh – gave synopsis of how the University of Houston is doing with Achieving the Dream. A Q & A discussion with the Council followed.
