A Registration and Academic Records/PeopleSoft (Debbie Hermann)

Registrar Debbie Hermann informed the Council that there are a total of 235 NR grades for the academic year. 154 NR grades were from spring 2010.

B Office of Admissions (Djuana Young)

Executive Director Djuana Young announced that the Office of Admissions is focusing on Orientations and that they just started holding sessions. Around 1800 freshmen registered for NSO. At the first orientation, a little over 160 students attended the New Student Orientation and 313 students attended the second NSO. Admissions goal is to have 600 students registered for orientation. As for the ART conferences, a little over 1800 transfer students registered. The conferences have been running smoothly.

He mentioned that these changes will be finalized during the first UC meeting for fall 2010.

C Faculty Senate Unification Meeting

Simon Bott attended today's Faculty Senate Unification meeting which focuses on creating a consistent & united voice regarding proposed policy changes at UH. Chairs of standing councils meet with the FS Executive Committee to share important business items that impact UH campuswide. There's a goal to eventually integrate the standing council chairs into the FS Executive Committee. Simon Bott assured the Council that this unification wouldn't change the structure or business of standing councils.

VI New Business

Athletics Promotion (Simon Bott)

UC Vice Chair Simon Bott announced to the UC that this is a crucial year for UH Athletics because of the Conference Realignment. In order for UH to have a successful conference realignment, UH needs to increase fan support via a large push to increase season ticket holders among faculty and staff. Dr. Bott asked the UC to help distribute and advertise season ticket forms to faculty and staff and there's a contest to sell tickets.
