III Administrative Representatives' Reports

A Agnes DeFranco, Undergraduate Studies

PeopleSoft 9.0 is now programmed so that TSI stops can be placed on a student's account if necessary. Students who are not TSI complete will need to register in the necessary remedial courses during their first semester at UH. A state bill requires an undergraduate student to file a degree plan when they reach 45 semester credit hours. UH requires undeclared FTICs to declare a major when they reach 30 semester credit hours: UH is compliant in this area. However, transfer students will now need to declare a major upon admissions if they have more than 45 semester credit hours.

B Steve Soutullo, Student Access and Success

Steve informed the UC that there has been an amendment to the state law requiring students living in dormitories to be vaccinated against bacterial meningitis. The amended law now requires all students attending college (living on campus and commuting) to have been immunized against the bacterial meningitis. This includes students who have been out one or more semesters. Students thirty years old and older are exempt from this requirement. Students will need to bring proof of immunization or physician's letter stating exemption. UH's Health Center will be ready to give vaccinations.

C Sal Loria, Scholarships and Financial Aid

About 258 students were eligible to receive Academic Excellence & Tier One scholarships. The Office of Scholarships and Financial Aid were able to offer these scholarships to students a month early.

Also state law requires institutions of higher education to calculate gap academic progress every semester. SFA has established a new process in which students who are not making satisfactory academic progress (i.e., probation) must submit an appeal each semester until good academic standing is obtained.

D Debbie Henry, Registration and Academic Records

Preregistration begins in early November and students can view enrollment appointments already. The "fourth attempt enrollment" was set up in PeopleSoft and will be in place for spring 2012 registration. Repeat rule policy mechanism was updated in PeopleSoft and will be ready for graduation certification.

A Online Courses

UC Chair Simon Bott asked the UC faculty senators to review their college's online courses. He charged Richard Scamell's Academic Policies & Procedures subcommittee to look at online education. He read out seven prioritized points that he would like the subcommittee to consider and encouraged UC members to contribute to the APP subcommittee discussion. An electronic copy of the charge will be distributed to the UC by Jeanette Morales. Sal Loria mentioned that financial aid formula change will occur depending on the number of online courses offered. Simon asked him to send a SFA representative to serve as an advisor in the APP subcommittee. Sal said he would the person to serve in this capacity. Libby Barlow asked Simon to also add a charge to look at the new core requirements with regard to online education.

Dr. Bott asked the UC members to let Richard Scamell or himself know if there's anyone else who would be helpful to contribute to this task.

B Simon Bott mentioned that Richard Walker, VC/VP for Student Affairs would like to add another Student Affairs representative to the Undergraduate Committee.
