#### A Djuana Young, Office of Admissions

About 223 students attended the first orientation. The freshman application deadline (April 1, 2014) has already passed. 2051 students have registered for orientation. The transfer application deadline is drawing close (June 1, 2014). 1245 transfer students signed up for ART conferences so far.

#### B Debbie Henry, Office of Registration and Academic Records

18,887 students enrolled for fall 2014 semester (about 3.1% down compared to Fall 2013). For summer sessions 1, 2, and 3, 9,801 students enrolled. 4,427 enrolled for 2014 summer session 4. The Wait List function is being utilized by departments. Curriculog access notice will be sent this week to associate and assistant deans first before the general broadcast email. RAR staff will help departments with the workflow process training.
