- Use LAUNCH - **L**earning **A**dvancements for **U**ndergraduate **C**ougars of **H**ouston for tutoring and learning strategies counseling
- Meet with a Success Advocate to discuss Spring Pathway coursework
- Satisfy Fall and Spring course requirements (full time=12 hours/semester)
- UHin4= 15 hours/semester fall 2019, 30 credits by end of summer 2020
- Choose a major and declare by 30 UH credit hours
