

ECE 6364/5354 Digital Video

You can combine your audio and video into a single mpeg file using Microsoft Windows Movie Maker. This is probably already installed on your windows PC.

In Windows XP, Windows Movie Maker is located at your "Start" icon at the bottom-left of your screen, under all programs, accessories, entertainment. In Vista, you can find it at your "Start" icon at the bottom-left of your screen, under all programs.

1. Launch Windows Movie maker.
2. Click on "Import Video" under Movie task "Capture Video" and browse to find your animated MPEG. Movie maker will read in your mpeg and place an icon for your mpeg in the window. Click on "Import audio or music" and browse to find your chosen mp3. Movie maker will read in your mp3 and place an icon for your mp3 in the window.
3. Select (click) and drag the mpeg icon to the "Storyboard" timeline at the bottom of the window. Do the same with the mp3 icon.
4. Under Movie tasks to the left of the Movie Maker window, you will find "Finish Move". Under "Finish Movie" select "Save to my computer" to combine video with audio into a single mpeg file.

Turn in the mpeg file for your project.
